No current Boat Safety Certificate (BSC)

The boat includes 240V hookup, a small inverter, and solar panels. Buyers should assume none of the systems are working, and it is recommended to have a full out of water survey.

Internally, there is a galley and L-shaped seating area, it has a separate bathroom with cassette toilet, and a large wet room opposite.

The engine runs, and there is extensive documentation and paperwork with the boat.

The boat is priced accordingly, based on its current condition.
