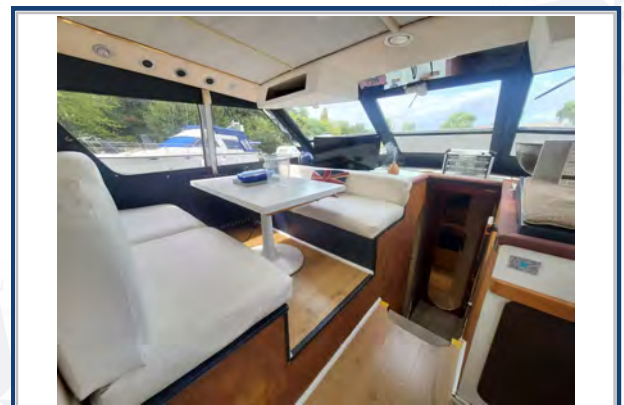
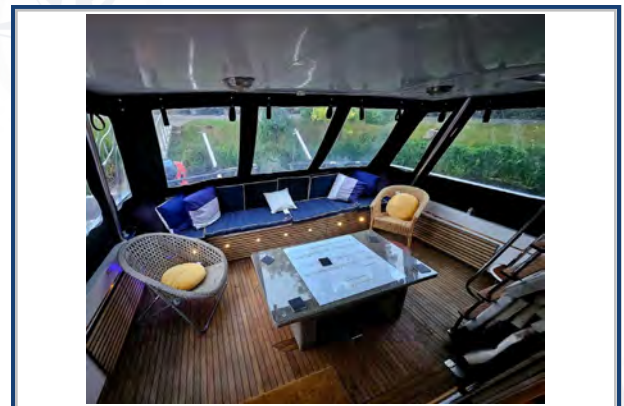
The setup onboard is robust and clearly laid out.

Hot Water & Heating

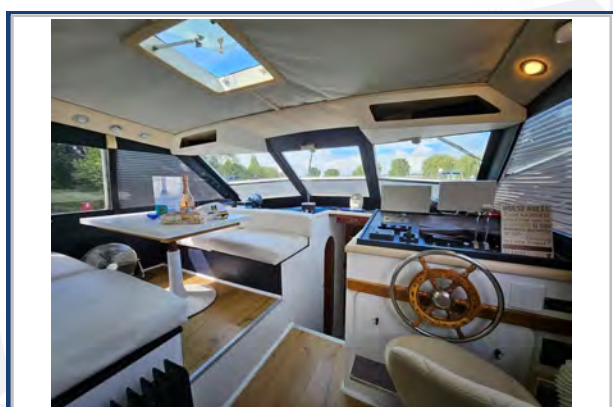
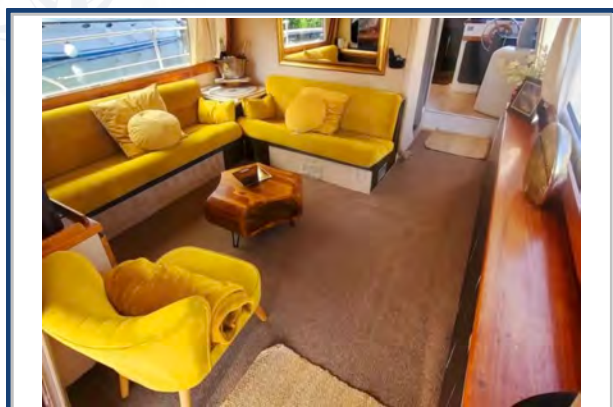
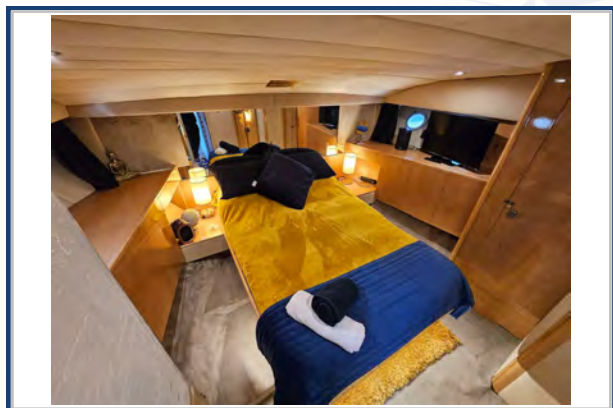
Hot water is provided by a large water tank with heating elements which feed to an electric heater. Heating is provided by a Blow Air system.

General Layout & Accommodation

Designed with comfortable cruising and time aboard in mind, the layout is both practical and well balanced:

Accommodation

Two comfortable cabins

- Forward cabin with a generous double berth and storage
- Midships cabin with twin berths (often convertible, depending on fit-out)

Two heads, typically:

- One serving the forward cabin
- One serving the midships / guest area

Separate shower arrangements are common on this model.

Main Deck

- Raised wheelhouse / helm position with excellent all-round visibility
- Spacious saloon with seating and dining area, benefitting from good natural light
- Galley located on the main deck level, well placed for both interior living and entertaining

Flybridge & Exterior

- Flybridge helm with seating for guests — a real social space underway or at anchor
- Wide side decks for easy movement around the boat
- Practical foredeck with room for sun pads or deck furniture.
