Anchor is a 54ft traditional butty, built by the Harris Brothers. With an iron hull and steel top, she's rich in history — her origins stretch back to 1919, and she was officially registered in 1943.

Though she has no engine, she shines through in the quality of construction and the carefully designed interior. She brings together classic heritage, comfortable living, and great potential. Anchor was freshly blacked in 2024, and holds a valid Boat Safety Certificate until October 2027

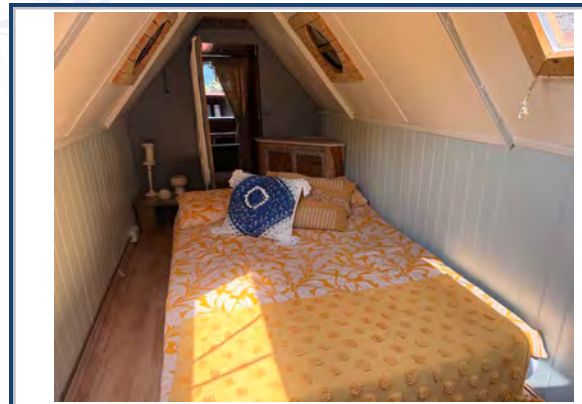
Anchor is an impressive 54ft traditional butty, crafted by the Harris Brothers. She features an iron hull and steel top, and is steeped in history — her origins trace back to 1919, with official registration taking place in 1943.

While she does not have an engine, her true appeal lies in her fine craftsmanship and carefully designed interior. There are two solid fuel stoves to keep things warm and welcoming, plus a well-appointed walk-through bathroom fitted with a roll-top bath, Thetford toilet, and vanity basin.

Accommodation is spacious and versatile: a fixed double berth, a second double that can be made up in the boatman's cabin, and a futon — providing comfortable sleeping space for up to six people. Her systems are thoughtfully equipped too, with 12v and 240v electrics, three leisure batteries, and a Sterling inverter (approximately 150W) to support everyday modern conveniences.

The hull was professionally blacked in 2024, and she holds a valid Boat Safety Certificate until October 2027. Anchor presents a wonderful opportunity to own a genuine piece of canal heritage — a characterful craft that is both practical and ready for new adventures.
